

# Create Your QR Code

## Purpose

Incorporate QR Codes into your LifeExec Documents to streamline website access from mobile devices. This document outlines one method for generating QR Codes that directly link to your website. Feel free to explore alternative methods. Any functional QR Code is acceptable.

## What You Need

- Your Webpage
- Chrome Browser

## Create and Save QR Code

1. Open your webpage in Chrome Browser
2. Click the ellipses (three vertical dots) in the top righthand corner of the browser.
3. Select Share and Save > Create QR Code

A popup module will appear with a QR Code for your webpage. The module might disappear if you click outside the module. Simple repeat the process if your QR Code disappears.

4. Click Download.

Your computer will save your QR code in your Downloads folder. We recommend moving the QR Code to a location for continue use.

## Use Your QR Code in LifeExec Documents

Each LifeExec Document includes a square designated for your QR Code. You can add your QR Code into any document using a graphic application, online application like Canva (free), or just copy and pasting both the document graphic and QR code into common applications like Word or PowerPoint.
